#### About NSN Connect and this document

**NSN Connect** has been developed to offer secure, quick-and-easy, online remote-access to your irrigation PC from any PC or Mac without the need to change the configuration of, or install any software on, the local computer.

This guide offers you a general overview of features offered by NSN Connect. More information, including the installation process and a Quick Start guide, is available in the separate documents. For more information, contact Toro NSN at 800-ASK-TORO.

#### Glossary of terms used in NSN Connect

The following terms are used in reference to NSN Connect:

- **Remote computer:** the computer being controlled remotely. You can only remotely control computers to which you've previously installed the NSN Connect service.
- **Local computer:** any computer that an NSN Connect user is using to remotely control a remote computer.

## NSN Connect Features

<b>USAGE FEATURES</b>	
<b>Remote Access and Control</b>	Access and control your irrigation computer (including SitePro) from any other computer or Windows Mobile device connected to the Internet.
<b>Drag &amp; Drop File Transfer</b>	File transfer uses a quick-and-easy visual interface, which is split into two with the remote computer's directory tree on one side and the local computer's on the other.
<b>Copy and Paste – Clipboard</b>	Copy and paste text between the local and remote computers without having to transfer files.
<b>Local Printing of Remote Documents</b>	Print documents stored on remote machines right to local printers, with no printer configuration required.
<b>Multi-platform (PC, Mac, iPhone, Pocket PC / Windows Mobile) remote control</b>	Remotely control from various different operating systems: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Windows</li> <li>- Mac</li> <li>- iPhone</li> <li>- Pocket PC / Windows Mobile</li> </ul>
<b>Invitation to share desktop</b>	Send other users an invitation to remotely control your computer (granting them temporary permission that expires within a maximum of 24 hours). The remote control can optionally be in observer mode only, and you can also view a list of all of your pending invitations.
<b>Multi-browser</b>	Compatible with Internet Explorer (including IE 7), Netscape, Firefox, Safari, Camino and Windows Mobile for Pocket PC.
<b>Remote access from Pocket PC / Windows Mobile</b>	Access your PC's data, documents, and programs from your iPhone, Pocket PC, or Windows Mobile device.
<b>Mini-map (for Pocket PC / Windows Mobile)</b>	View the whole of the remote desktop in a miniature visualisation area and go to any part of a screen with a single click.
<b>Zoom (for Pocket PC / Windows Mobile)</b>	View a smaller or larger portion of the remote desktop.
<b>Auto-scaling</b>	Scale the image of the remote desktop so that it exactly fills the remote control window.
<b>Full screen</b>	Fill the local computer's screen with a scaled image of the whole of the remote desktop.
<b>Variable color-depth (2, 16, 256, 65536 and true color)</b>	Select the number of colors that are used to display the remote desktop. This can be set from the 'View' menu of the remote control window's floating toolbar. Keep in mind that increasing the number of colors may decrease the screen refresh rate.
<b>View account activity</b>	Show all connections that were made to a computer during a specific date-range.
<b>Activity reports and notifications of unusual events</b>	View reports on connections, security events, and access history, or a summary of computer access.
<b>Keyboard, mouse and screen blocking</b>	Increase connection confidentiality by automatically blocking the remote-computer's keyboard, mouse and screen.

<b>SECURITY FEATURES</b>	
<b>256-bit Encryption</b>	All communication is sent encrypted with the 256-bit AES point-to-point algorithm.
<b>Security Reports</b>	View all login attempts
<b>Secure Access</b>	Access is protected by password and security reports.
<b>Computer password</b>	Optionally specify that an additional password that must be entered in order to access a computer. In this case the user will have to enter up to three different passwords.
<b>Automatic blocking of remote computer on disconnection</b>	Automatically block the remote computer when you finish a remote-control session.
<b>Auto-disconnection</b>	Automatically disconnect from a remote-control session after the specified number of minutes.
<b>Define a valid range of IPs for a computer</b>	Define the range of IP addresses from which a remote connection will be permitted to this computer. Attempts to connect from addresses outside this range will not be permitted.
<b>Set a timetable</b>	Define time periods during which remote connections are permitted. Attempts to connect at times outside these periods will not be permitted.
<b>NSN Connect High-Speed platform</b>	Connect to the new NSN Connect platform ensuring the highest security and reliability.
<b>Advanced Keycard Security</b>	Choose the special authentication mode, and it will be necessary to enter a code before performing certain restricted actions.
