## Connecting from a Windows Mobile device

To start remote control from a Windows Mobile device, follow these steps (the steps and figures are for an installation on Microsoft Windows Mobile 6):

- 1) Turn on the mobile device.



- 2) Open Internet Explorer by clicking on the '**Internet Explorer**' option (2) from the '**Start**' menu (1).

- 3) Enter [www.nsnconnect.com](http://www.nsnconnect.com) into the address bar and click on the green arrow to open the webpage.

4) Once it has been detected that you are using a Windows Mobile device, NSN Connect will redirect you to the Windows Mobile login page. Enter your username and password and click on the 'Login' button.



5) If this is the first time that you have entered, you will see a screen inviting you to download an installer. If you have connected to NSN Connect before, you can skip to step 6.



Click on the link and you will see a new window. Click on **'Yes'** to confirm that you want to download the NSN Connect cab file and install it on your Windows Mobile device.



If asked for an install location, choose 'Device' and click Install.



6) You will now see your computer list. Click on the name of the irrigation computer to begin a remote control session.



If a password has been specified on the computer to which you are trying to connect you will also be asked to enter that.

8) You will now see the computer's desktop on your Pocket PC. You can also view the computer while your device is in landscape mode.



You can now interact with the remote computer as you would if you were using it directly.

The mouse action buttons allow you to modify the action taken on the remote computer when you touch the screen with your stylus. There are four options, which, from left to right, are: (1) no action, (2) left click, (3) right click, and (4) double click. This means that, for example, to double left-click you need to first press the double-click button (thereby activating a persistent double-click mode) then press the left-click button.

## Options

- **'View'** submenu

Here you can choose between viewing the remote desktop in 2, 16, 256 or 65536 colors. The fewer colors you choose, the faster will be the screen update.

You can choose the **'Refresh'** option to repaint the screen.

- **'Actions'** submenu

By choosing the **'Ctrl+Alt+Del'** option you can send a 'ctl+alt+del' command to the remote computer.

- **'Help'** submenu

By choosing the **'About'** option you can view version and resource-usage information.

- **'Minimize'** option

Minimize the remote-control window.

- **'Exit'** option

End the remote control session.

## Zoom

You can use the zoom controls to view more or less of the remote computer screen.

## Mini map

If you are viewing your remote computer screen in real size, you can use the mini map to quickly move around the remote computer screen without having to scroll. The mini map shows you the full screen of the remote computer in a small area at the bottom of your Windows Mobile device. To view an area of the remote computer screen using the mini map, click anywhere inside the mini map – the corresponding area of the remote computer is displayed on your device.
